

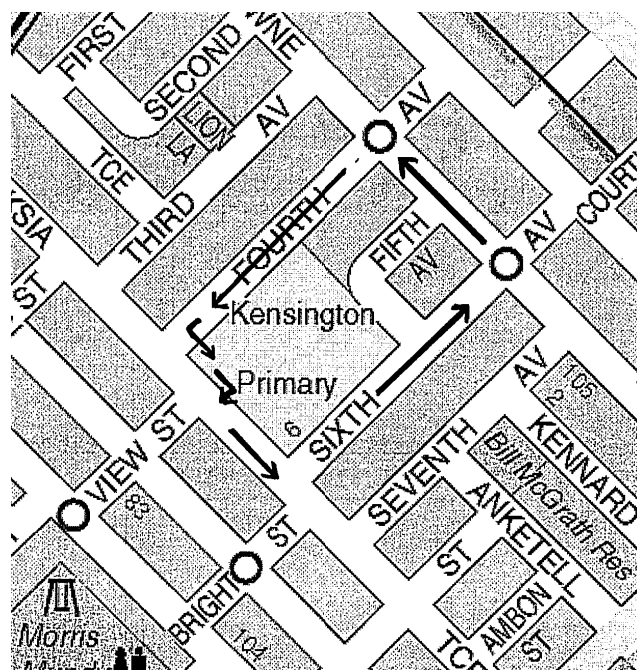
The area around school becomes extremely hazardous especially during the peak afternoon pick up period. This causes concern for parents and can be very distressing for the students.

Your co-operation and patience in using the Kiss and Drive system will provide your children with a safer, less traumatic environment.

The driveway (Gate) off Fourth Ave onto the Basketball courts is designated Kiss & Drive vehicle area especially set aside for the set-down and pick up of students.

HOW THE KISS & DRIVE WORKS

- Move as near to the front of the Kiss & Drive area as possible.
- Always be courteous to other road users.
- Children will wait in the school grounds near the Kiss & Drive area.
- Area to be used only for set down and pick up of students.
- If your child is not ready don't stop, move on, drive around the block and try again.
- No overtaking in the Kiss & Drive area.
- No parking permitted in the Kiss & Drive area.
- Always indicate to enter and leave the Kiss & Drive area.
- Always exit to the left - No right turn onto Banksia Terrace.
- Ensure children entering the vehicle put on their seat restraint.



BENEFITS

- Quicker, safer operation to set down and pick up children.
- Less parking hassles.
- Less waiting.
- Leave home later - get home quicker.

HOW TO USE THE KISS & DRIVE AREA

Morning

- Stop in Kiss & Drive area (move as far forward as possible).
- Students alight from **left** of vehicle.
- Parents/carers must remain in the vehicle.
- When students are clear of vehicle indicate right and enter traffic flow.

Afternoon

- Queue in Fourth Ave (see attached map for traffic flow).
- Students enter by the **left** of the vehicle.
- If children are not ready drive on around the block and rejoin the queue.
- It is extremely important that you:

Keep the engine running - Apply the handbrake - Stay in the vehicle
