



ENROLMENT - Measurement of Distance From the School

Under *the Interpretations Act 1984* page 45, Part V111 – Section 65: Provisions regarding time and distance: *In the measure of any distance for the purpose of a written law, the distance shall be measured in a straight line on a horizontal plane.*

For consistency, to determine which student lives nearest the school, the distance should be measured in a straight line from the centre of the school site.

For the Kensington off- site kindergarten this policy also applies that is, to determine which student lives nearest the school, the distance should be measured in a straight line from the centre of the school site.

Rationale

Enrolment processes must be fair, open and consistent.

In applying this policy across all areas:-

- Policy remains consistent to past practices;
- The same ruling is maintained over Kindy and Pre – Primary; and
- Kensington Primary school, the measuring point, remains central within the catchment area.
